

The Clock Collection in display at the Topkapi Palace, Divit Hall on May 25, 2012 was made up of 380 mechanical clocks as diplomatic gifts to the Sultans or made by Turkish clock makers, put together by the Ottoman imperial family over a period of 4 centuries: the16 - 19th. The most outstanding piece was considered to be made by the renowned Breguet in1813 as a gift to Sultan Mahmud II, named "Pendule Sympathique".


